### OFFICIAL NOMINATION RULES

2. **Eligibility.** The Theater Educator Award can only be nominated by High School and University students who are residents of Indiana, Kentucky and Ohio at the time of entry and have a valid email address. Employees of Gannett Satellite Information Network, Inc. d/b/a The Enquirer, Gannett Co., Inc., Fifth Third Bank and each of their respective affiliated companies, subsidiaries, advertising or promotional agencies, and other agents, and the immediate family members of, and any persons domiciled with such employees, are not eligible to enter or to win.

Written nominations must be 500 words or less. VIDEO NOMINATIONS MUST BE THREE MINUTES OR LESS. NOTE SUPPORT MATERIALS ON THE NOMINATION FORM. All online entries must received by 11:59pm (E.S.T.) on March 31, 2011. Limit one entry per person during the competition.

Winner will be announced on May 23, 2011 at the Enquirer Acclaim Awards at the Aronoff Center's Jarson-Kaplan Theater. Return of prize notification as undeliverable may result in disqualification and an alternative winner may be selected. Winners may waive their right to receive prizes. Prizes are non-assignable and nontransferable. No substitutions allowed, except that prizes and individual components of prize packages are subject to availability and Sponsor reserves the right to substitute prizes of equal or greater value. In the event the competition is compromised by a virus, non-authorized human intervention, tampering or other causes beyond the reasonable control of judges, which corrupts or impairs the administration, security, fairness or proper operation of the competition, the judging panel reserves the right in its sole discretion to suspend, modify or terminate the competition. Should the competition be terminated prior to the stated expiration date, judges reserves the right to award prizes based on the entries received before the termination date.

7. Limitations of Liability.
